Repentance

Then Jesus said, “neither do I condemn you; go and sin no more.” ~John 8:11

There are numerous times in the bible where God teaches on repentance and the remissions of sins, whether it’s Jesus speaking or one of God’s prophets or disciples. This tells us that repentance and remissions of sins is such an importance part of our salvation and fellowship with the Father through Christ Jesus.

Matthew 4:17 – “From that time Jesus began to preach and to say, “Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand.”

- After Jesus was tried and tested, the cry and start of His ministry was, Repent, for the Kingdom of heaven is at hand.

Repentance according to *Dictionary.com*

1. deep sorrow, compunction, or contrition for a past sin, wrongdoing, or the like.
2. regret for any past action.

Repentance according to *Scripture*

1. **2 Corinthians 7:9-10** *“Now I rejoice, not that you were made sorry, but that your sorrow led to repentance. For you were made sorry in a godly manner, that you might surer loss from us in nothing. 10 For godly sorrow produces repentance leading to salvation, not to be regretted; but the sorrow of the world produces death.”*
2. **2 Cornicles 7:14** *“If My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive them their sin and heal their land.”*
3. **Acts 3:19** *“Repent therefore and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, so that times of refreshing may come from the presence of the Lord”*

Four points of Repentance according to scripture:

1. Repentance is deep sorrow for an action or sin that was committed
 - Unpleasing to God.
2. Paul tells us in Corinthians that repentance leads to salvations
 - Repentance purifies us causes our heart to break for what breaks Gods
3. Repentance is a way to God.
 - In 2 Cornicles 7:14; God is telling us that He will hear our cries, and our prayer if we:
 - Humble ourselves
 - Pray and seek Him
 - Turn from our wicked ways – **REPENT!!**
4. Through repentance; you’ll experience the fullness of God
 - Acts 3:19 tells us that through repentance, the times of refreshing may come from the presence of the God. – when we repent, we are telling The Holy Spirit and ourselves that we are ready to live a life all poured out and sacrificed, at the feet Jesus.
