



Living in the Overflow: Let's not carry the anointing of God just to say that we have it. Let's carry the anointing of God so that we have it in the Overflow. It is Gods will that no man shall perish. As children of God, who are carrying His anointing in the overflow, it is our job to ensure that God's will is fulfilled. So, as we are filled up beyond capacity, we are then able to pour out onto our brethren and the nations, so that no man shall perish, but all should come to repentance. 2 Peter 3:9

Matthew 25:1-9

Points to acknowledge:

- Vs. 2. – 5 Foolish wives & 5 wise wives
- Vs. 3 – foolish wives took no oil
- Vs. 4 – wise wives took oil in their vessels

To make it clear, oil is significant of the Holy Spirit, vessels are our temples, our bodies. Some took part of the Holy Spirit and received the anointing of the Lord, some did not.

- Vs. 5 – They **all** slumbered and slept

Meaning both the foolish and the wise bride who had the anointing of the Lord, slept. In other words, they heard the good news and after church, they did not do anything to maintain the oil, the anointing that was within their vessels.

- Vs. 6 – Bridegroom is coming go and meet Him – Jesus's Kingdom has touched earth, the day we've all be waiting for is here.
- Vs. 7 – all virgins /wives trimmed their lamps. Got their vessels in order, turned their light on for the Lord
- Vs. 8 – Foolish wives requested oil from the wise virgin – *Their lamps are going out*
- Vs. 9 – The wise virgins replied – no, lest there is not enough for us.

When looking at this passage we always look at the foolish wives.
