Fruit and Scriptures:

Fruit	Scripture	Message:
Love	1. Corinthians 13:4-10 & 10:13 2. John 14:21 3. 1 Peter 4:8	Love is the greatest barrier of them all. As Christ endured in love, so shall we. It's through love that the commandments & the great commission is fulfilled (Exodus 20:4-17 & Matthew 28:18-20)
Peace	 Proverbs 17:27-28 1 Peter 3:11 John 14:27 	Peace is the calmness of the Spirit. Peace knowing that this world is not the end all be all. Peace knowing that Greater is coming. Peace knowing that all you go through there is a Kingdom that is tangible.
Joy	 John 15:11 1 Peter 4:12-14 Acts 20:24 	Joy comes from abiding in the Father. True joy cannot be obtained from the world. Your joy is found in the Lord.
Longsuffering	 Romans 8:18 1 Peter 3:14 Isaiah 40:31 	Longsuffering is your endurance. Your ability to stand, your faith in the Lord to remain despite the battles and what you may face or what you may see. Though you may suffer long, it will never compare to the glory that is to be revealed in you!
Kindness	 Proverbs 31:26 1 Peter 4:9 	Kindness is an act of being. It's how you interact with your counterparts. It's a natural ability that automatically comes out of you.
Goodness	1. Peter 3:11 2. 1 Peter 3:17	Like Kindness, goodness is a natural thing that comes out of you. as you continue to grow in the Lord, naturally, you'll desire to do good.
Faithfulness	1. Romans 10:17 2. Hebrews 11:1 & 11:6 3. 1 Peter 4:19	As God is faithful to us, so we strive to be faithful to Him. Knowing that we hope to obtain His goodness. Though faith is the substance of what we cannot see, We know that Jesus is the evidence in which we hope. So, we remain faithful to Him and in Him.
Gentleness	1. 1 Peter 3:1-4	Gentleness and a reflection of what is on the inside. It's a state of character. It protrudes from our spirit. As we're gentle to others, they will naturally be drawn to us, and attach to the father, for our spirit is the spirit of Christ that they see.
Self-control	1. Ephesians 4:26	Self-control, put aside your flesh, put aside your earthly desires, and long for the fulness of Christ.
